Approval of 2020 VAWA policy

HUD requires that the VAWA Emergency Transfer Policy be updated annually. This policy was updated twice in 2019 to incorporate updates to fulfill both HUD and the NC ESG office requirements of the policy. The 2020 updates are minimal and do not change the content of the policy but do fix small errors in grammar and better align jargon. The bigger change to the policy is to create the Emergency Transfer Plan as a fillable form, instead of a PDF, to better assist agencies adopting the plan.

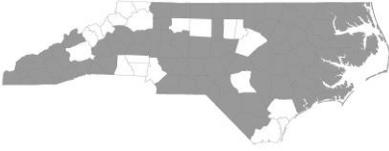

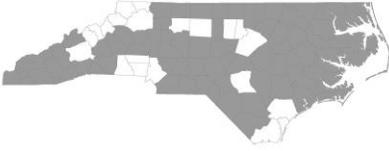

Point-in-Time/Housing Inventory Count (PIT/HIC) Update

The 2020 Point-in-Time/Housing Inventory Count was conducted on the night of January 29. Additional service-based surveys were collected through Feb 5. NC BoS CoC and HMIS@NCCEH staff have partnered to collect and analyze data on people experiencing homelessness and housing inventory from all agencies in the CoC. Over 150 agencies do not participate in HMIS, requiring individual follow-up, which has been the focus of the work in February. As information becomes available, it will be reported to this committee and posted to the www.ncceh.org website.
