	Background Information: Last week, Governor Roy Cooper issued an executive order regarding the application of the CDC eviction moratorium in North Carolina. The order clarifies that renters can use the CDC Declaration form to prevent being evicted and requires landlords to provide tenants with a blank copy of the form. It does not prevent the landlord from beginning the eviction process.
