





Important community data for funding, stakeholders, and governance


- Deep data: covers HMIS and non-HMIS projects as well as people living unsheltered
- Consistent data: completed every year
- Consequential data: used by HUD, NC ESG Office, and others to determine funding for CoCs/regions




Point-in-Time and Housing Inventory Counts

Combining Data & Reporting

NCCEH staff will combine data and submit reports.

Role: Unsheltered Access Coordinator

- Elected position for each region to support CE identification of people living unsheltered
- Facilitates data collection and entry so folks experiencing unsheltered homelessness can access resources
 - Coordinates referrals to CE
- Leads collection, entry, and verification of data for PIT night
 - Organizes volunteers for verification surveys night-of or immediately after PIT night



Steering Committee approved a slate of project applications for CY2022 ESG Annual Allocation funds

- The NC BoS CoC Steering Committee approved the Project Review Committee's recommended slate of project applications at the September 07 meeting.
- The approved slate maximized the Fair Share allotted to the NC BoS CoC by the NC ESG office for these funds.
- Two agencies decided to withdraw their application after being notified, and amendments were made to the regional budget to maintain the full Fair Share for each region.



The NC ESG Office has finalized the awards for funding in 2022.

- The NC ESG Office made only 1 adjustment to funding amounts submitted in the NC BoS CoC Regional Application:
 - Family Abuse Services of Alamance County (Region 06): The NC ESG Office declined to award homelessness prevention (HP) funds to Family Abuse Services, lowering their total award from \$106,057 (approved by CoC) to \$75,000 (awarded by ESG).
 - The NC ESG Office agreed to reallocate the difference of \$31,057 within the region to maximize the Fair Share for Region 06. NC BoS CoC precedent dictates that reallocated funds be directed to RRH Financial Assistance within the region.
 - Central Piedmont Community Action has agreed to take on the reallocated funds into RRH Financial Assistance for CY2022.



Contracting should be finishing up with each agency.

- The NC ESG Office has sent out all contracts to approved agencies.
- If your agency has not finished signing and returning the contracts to the NC ESG Office for your awarded CY2022 grants, reach out to them ASAP!
