CoC Application Scorecards

AHAR (Annual Homeless Assessment Report)

- The Annual Homeless Assessment Report (AHAR) is a report to the U.S. Congress on the extent and nature of homelessness in America. The report is prepared by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and provides nationwide estimates of homelessness, including information about the demographic characteristics of homeless persons, service use patterns, and the capacity to house homeless persons. The report is based primarily on Homeless Management Information Systems (HMIS) data about persons who experience homelessness during a 12-month period.

AHAR (Annual Homeless Assessment Report)

- Communities contribute data from their HMIS & PIT count
- Must have good data quality to be allowed to contribute
 - Bed utilization between 65-105%
 - HUD checks data for discrepancies and errors
- We couldn't submit data for PSH-FAM all persons and PSH-FAM veterans shells because of data errors
 - AHAR participation is scored in the CoC application
 - Submitting data helps HUD and Congress get an accurate picture of our communities
- Improve your data quality!
 - Respond to CHIN's emails about data quality reviews
 - Register for the [Data Quality Subcommittee](#) on March 26

New HEARTH Requirements

- **Governance:** The Balance of State will be reviewing its governance structure and policies this spring in order to ensure compliance with HEARTH regulations.
- **Coordinated Assessment:** All CoCs are required to implement a CoC-wide Coordinated Assessment System.
- This planning will have to be done at the Steering Committee level. Regional Committees will have some flexibility, but there needs to be a consistent, overarching process for both of these requirements.
