Point-in-Time Count

- Local PIT Coordinators
 - Make sure all agencies reported for PIT & HIC
 - ES, TH, RRH, PSH
 - Review and verify data for accuracy
 - De-duplicate and compile unsheltered count
 - Submit forms to NCCEH
- NCCEH compiles CoC-wide count, submits PIT
 & HIC to HUD



Point-in-Time Count

- HMIS PIT report released
 - NCCEH & CHIN in touch with HMIS agencies

- HMIS Agencies
 - Due Wednesday, March 11
 - Submit HMIS PIT report and NC PIT form
- Non-HMIS agencies & unsheltered counts
 - Were due Friday, Feb. 20
 - Submit immediately if haven't already

CA Plan Submission

- CAC reviewed 5 plans in February
 - Weather delays continue
- CAC will continue plan review
 - 2 meetings in March
 - 9 plans currently ready
 - NCCEH staff continue threshold reviews
 - Posting plan materials on NCCEH website as they pass threshold



Revised CA Plan Review Process

- After plan review, each Regional Committee will get a call from 1-2 CAC members and an NCCEH staff member to offer feedback on CA plans

Burke CA Plan

- Originally reviewed in January
 - Regional Committee did a good job implementing CAC recommendations
- Strong plan elements
 - Agencies travel to perform the assessment (pg. 17)
 - Commitment from agencies to ensure transportation to first appointments (pg. 19)



Catawba CA Plan

- Thoughtful, thorough plan
- Strong plan elements
 - Large number of staff assisting with coordinated assessment (pg. 16)
 - Agencies doing walk-in assessments (pg. 16)
 - Bus service + plan to travel to those in need to complete assessments (pg. 17)
 - Services linked to coordinated assessment (pg. 18)

Coordinated Assessment - Next Steps

- After plans approved
 - Implementation
 - Training videos for assessment tool
 - Prevention and diversion screen
 - VI-SPDAT
 - Case management tool
- After CAC review
 - Plan to schedule phone call after CAC plan review
 - 1-2 CAC members + NCCEH staff
 - Regional Lead, CA Lead, others

FY 2015 CoC Grant Competition

- NCCEH submitted Grant Inventory Worksheet (GIW) to HUD on February 16 for Field Office/HQ review
- Includes all grants eligible for renewal in FY 2015
 - 51 grants
 - Preliminary Annual Renewal Amount (ARA) = \$6,794,653
- Next steps
 - GIW finalized by HUD by March 16
 - NOFA, end of May?
 - Begins Consolidated and Project Application process



FY 2015 CoC Grant Competition

- Regional Committees appoint one rep for Scorecard Committee
 - Project Review Committee appointed after NOFA released (Summer 2015)
- Responsibilities of Scorecard Committee
 - Determines criteria and scoring guidelines for new and renewal project scorecards
 - First meeting (mandatory attendance)

FY 2015 CoC Grant Competition

- Funding context
 - No new project funds FY 2013 competition
 - Reallocation funds only
 - Bonus projects for FY 2014 competition
 - NC BoS unlikely to qualify
 - Reallocation also possible/encouraged by HUD
- Agencies interested in applying for NEW projects
 - Complete FY2015 CoC Intent to Apply form
 - http://bit.ly/1LEJDzO
 - Renewal projects do not need to complete this form



2015 BoS Regional Committees

- 2014: 30 Regional Committees
- 2 Regional Committees de-activated
 - Carteret, Person
 - No regular meetings, no minutes, no coordinated assessment plans
- 3 Regional Committees on bubble
 - Harnett, Rutherford, Southeast
 - Sporadic meetings (or just ramping up) and minutes,
 no coordinated assessment plans submitted



2015 BoS Regional Committees

 - Davie/Surry/Stokes + Iredell Yadkin
 - Now DISSY
- 2015
 - 25 Regional Committees in good standing
 - Regular, public meetings
 - Sending minutes to NCCEH
 - Coordinated assessment underway
 - 3 Regional Committees pending
 - Implications and next steps?
