Letter of Consistency

Religious Community Services requested a letter of consistency from the BoS.

- Applying for NC Housing Finance Agency's Supportive Housing Program
- Renovate community kitchen
 - Expand capacity from 40 to 120 people
- Renovate shelter facility
 - Add 4 family rooms
 - Add 6 rooms for Veterans
- Serves Craven, Jones, and Pamlico Counties
- Discussion and motion



CoC Competition

HUD intends to continue moving up the timeline for the CoC competition

- HUD outlined its timeline intentions for this year's and subsequent competitions
 - NOFA release: May
 - Close: August
 - Awards: Mid-December

• The Grant Inventory Worksheet (GIW) should be released soon and then registration for the competition

Measure 1: Length of time homeless

Goal	Reduction in the average and median length of time persons remain homeless		
Reported in 2016		Avg LOT Homeless	Median LOT homeless

Measure 2: Returns to Homelessness

Goal	Reduction in the percent of persons who return to homelessness

Reported in 2016

Exit From	Return less than 6 months	Return within 6-12 months	Return 13-24 months
SO	11%	11%	6%
ES	13%	1%	3%
TH	4%	5%	0%
PH	2%	2%	2%
Total Returns	8%	4%	2%



Measure 3: Number of homeless persons

Reduction in the number of persons who are homeless (PIT count)

Measure 5: Homeless for the first time

Measure 7b: PH placement and retention

Goal	Increase in percentage of people who exit to or retain permanent housing	
Reported in 2016	% Persons who exited to PH % Persons who exited to PH + remained	FY 2015 42% 96%
