


Making progress in data quality

We saw better data collection taking place across the board!

- 
- Fewer null/missing Exit Destinations (and only 1 Safe Haven!)
 - Fewer 0 day Returns to Homelessness
 - Fewer Annual Assessments out of range
 - Fewer Overlapping entries



Disabling Condition

HUD clarified this week that Disabling Condition is only collected at Entry

- Should always be accurate on the Entry Assessment
- No estimate yet MCAH if any changes in assessments are forthcoming

CoC-APR and ESG-CAPER

Updates coming in October

- PSH will be included in Housing Move-In date question

SSVF Export

Updates complete for SSSVF providers.

- DQ report only appears on the Repository once a submission is accepted

Questions

Are you the only provider that is serving this clients?

Is anyone else possibly reporting on this client?

Is anything missing on HMIS?

- Funding source, Bed inventory, Projects

Privacy and Security

Third party HMIS data sharing is prohibited except with sharing agreements and client consent

Before you share, do you have Sharing Agreement documentation in place? Do you have the client's consent to share data with that specific partner?

Locking down information for particular clients after a sharing agreement is in place is available. Have you needed to do that?

Data Questions to Ask

Ourselves and each other

How/When to use data from HMIS

Workflow

How is intake data collected? What information is consistently missing or flagging?

How is your agency collecting Exit Destination?

Does everyone collecting data for HMIS entry understand what/why data is collected?

How/When to use data from HMIS

Outcomes at your agency and within the community

Project Length – what is the length of time in shelter or transitional housing? What is the time it takes to find housing?

Exit Destinations – are we connecting clients to Permanent Housing?

Are we more and more Housing First?
