Salvation Army – not full, 15 beds available. ED of Boys and Girls club resigned on Friday. Getting new officers this summer, Major Trailer and his wife out of GA.

CVBH & population Health Management – also was able to move a mental health specialist position at the jail

New septic system in at the Kwanzaa Family Inn. Assessed by the state, Chris Battle came for site visit.

McDowell Mission/Friendship Home – increased resident retention through new policies and community partners.

VAYA helps with housing grant requests to other organizations – for those who do not know. Will help with security deposit, first month's rent or security deposit for utilities to be turned on.

Family Guidance Center – remained full all year.

**Continued concern about lack of affordable housing in our region.

Homeless Veterans – applied for new grant, will find out in July
