



Let's continue with a focus on the **Sheltered Count** for Emergency Shelters, Transitional Housing, and a few non-HMIS Rapid Re-Housing and Permanent Supportive Housing projects.



Steps to a non-HMIS Sheltered PIT/HIC

- 1. Practice with the Counting Us App
- 2. Confirm your NCCEH staff contact
- 3. Conduct PIT surveys of clients (with Counting Us App)
- 4. Check that all surveys submitted
- 5. Confirm all surveys submitted to your NCCEH staff contact
- 6. Review PIT data and participate in HIC survey with NCCEH staff
- 7. Respond to any follow-up questions

Key to success: Communication! (if you don't know your NCCEH contact, email bos@ncceh.org)



Tips for Good Etiquette During PIT:

General tips:

- Explain your role as a volunteer with the annual one-night homeless census of people experiencing homelessness.
- Use open-ended questions when asking demographic questions: "What is your gender?" or "What is your race?" of even add, "of these options..."
- It's ok to refuse questions! It's up to us to ask them.
- Remember you are asking for someone's time. Thank folks for their help.
 - Offering socks, hygiene products, or gift cards may help incentivize participation.

Sheltered Count:

- Survey individuals in private spaces whenever possible.
- Reinforce that answering PIT survey is not required to receive shelter services.



Why Use the Counting Us App



Accurate

- 1. Helps make sure everyone's experience is counted by age, race, ethnicity, gender, county, disability
- Geography and demographics can be crosstabulated
- 3. Helps de-duplicate folks

Logical question layout

- 1. Only applicable questions
 - Kids aren't asked if they're Veterans
 - You don't have to know the chronic homeless definition, automatic
- 2. Connect household members together

Easy

- 1. Works on phones, tablets, and computers connected to internet
- 2. Simple login, simple to reset passwords
- 3. Save results and submit later for bad cell coverage areas

Fast

- 1. Sends in real-time
- Reduces delay of both paper forms and back and forth questions

Secure

- All data transmitted to and from the command center is protected using RSA 2048-bit encryption
- 2. Access to the data is limited to CoC staff



Additional Security Procedures for VSPs

- Project Location:
 - A location is required (at least accurate for the County)
 - If there are concerns, use the address of your county's DSS
- Client Names:
 - Initials are required
 - Partial/Full names are encouraged to support de-duplication

 - Make sure you remember to submit all your drafts by February 3rd once you're back in range!
 - You can review drafts from the home page

<u>Step 1: Download the Counting Us mobile app</u> from <u>Google Play</u> or the <u>App Store</u>. Search for the term "Counting Us" or use the QR code to the right to find the app.

Step 6: Get Started






