- Review & Approval of January Minutes

- Balance of State Steering Committee Update
 - Reminder emails have not been going out. Destri contacted NCCEH who said the issue has now been fixed. Regular BOS meeting updates should resume in March.
- Coordinated Assessment Update
 - Region 1's Coordinated Assessment will be moving off of Google Docs and onto HMIS by April. The Coalition is looking for service providers willing to obtain an HMIS license (at no cost) and enter Coordinated Entry data for their clients or county. Interested agencies should contact Destri for more information.
- Rapid Rehousing Update

- Approximately \$13,000 of Rapid Rehousing assistance has been disbursed since 01/01/2020. Seven households have been housed and at least three have continued rental assistance.
- Destri suggested to the committee that the coordinated entry process be used more for entry purposes only and continued assistance should be determined by the agency responsible for the housing outcome (HERE). Mindy suggested using RAMM for requests for continued assistance that are denied. The group agreed to both suggestions.
