4. COC Competition FY21

- Secured Permanent Supportive Housing, Eastpointe (Serving Robeson, Bladen, Columbus, and Scotland County)
- Approved for 14 units
- Southeastern Domestic Violence Center applied for the Domestic Violence Rapid Re-Housing Funds

5. B@H Program COVID

- 15 individuals/families housed
- Counties covered: Robeson, Scotland, Bladen, Columbus Counties
- 65-70 people are on the waiting list across all counties
- Individual would need call 211 for Back at Home COVID
- Provides six months of rental assistance, utility assistance, and deposits.
- Rapid Re-Housing Requirements: Literally homeless and letter to be sent in from a providing agency as a referral, assessment would then be completed.
- Due to lack of applications for the Back at Home Florence program, the program has stopped.

6. Rapid Rehousing Program

- Currently housed six families for the year
- Five individuals are on the waiting list
- Encouraging assistance with finding additional landlords
- Three month assistance program

7. Permanent Supportive Housing

• 10 individuals housed and have a current waitlist

8. Coordinated Assessments

- No additional information at this time
- Plan of action for the region to assist with prevention and or rehousing through linkage with homelessness

9. Agency Updates/ Announcements

- A thank you was given to Lumberton Christian Care Center for hosting vaccinations for the homeless population.
- 40 individuals have been vaccinated as far through Lumberton Christian Care Center
- Scotland Church and Community Center have completed vaccinations as well
- Virginia Locklear noted that next Wednesday is Denim Day. Requesting that all agencies wear denim in solidary of survivors of sexual assault. April 28th.
- Continued funding for Back at Home COVID, Lumbee Tribe Rental Assistance Program, and Southeastern Partnership in Action.
