#### **Roll Call/Introductions**

• Everyone on the call introduced themselves and stated what agency they were from. Today, two new agencies joined the call – Inspiring Greatness and Touched by Loving Hands.

## **PIT Count** – Michele Welsh

- The PIT count will take place on January 25, 2023
- It is important that we report as many unsheltered homeless individuals as possible in each county. Funding for the region depends on the data that we collect
- Survey potentially unsheltered clients
  - o The survey can be conducted over the phone or in-person
  - When conducting the survey, as the individuals where they slept or plan to sleep the night of the 25<sup>th</sup>
    - Surveys are only valid if they are completed within 1 week after the 25<sup>th</sup>
- Since the region doesn't have a Unsheltered Access Coordinator, each region will need a point person
- The CE Lead will work close with the Unsheltered Access Coordinator to help support planning and action, help with unsheltered count data entry, and help influence relationships, as needed
- In the future, we would like to have street outreach in the region
- The CE Lead will be sent a \$100 Visa gift card to help purchase items to be placed in "goodie bags" for the homeless

#### **Lived Expertise Advisory Council**

• The LEAC has open seats starting January and are looking for people to fill those seats.

- The LEAC is a subcommittee of the NC BoS CoC Steering Committee composed of people who have experienced homelessness.
- Participation in the LEAC is compensated at \$15/hr. with a cap of 5 hours per month. The meetings are the second Friday of the month from 12pm 1pm.
- Qualifications
  - Have experienced homelessness within the last 7 years (or are still experiencing homelessness)
  - o Participated in the services within the NC BoS CoC (shelter, outreach, RRH, PSH, etc.)
  - o Passionate about improving the system, telling their story, and helping others
- If you, or someone you know may be interested in serving on the council, please let Lakitra know

- The following positions need to be filled: Regional Lead, Regional Alternate, Funding Process Lead, PIT Lead/Unsheltered Access Coordinator, Webmaster, and Project Review Committee Representative

  - Since no one volunteered for a position, another election will take place on December 12<sup>th</sup>

    - Anyone can attend the webinar; you don't have to be in a leadership position
