



Racial Equity Subcommittee Meeting NC Balance of State CoC November 16, 2022 at 11:30 AM







#### Camera

We have a lot of people! It may be easier to set the cameras to only show who is currently speaking. You can access this setting at the **top of the screen**.









### **Racial Equity Dialogue Series**

- Held 3 dialogue calls:
  - Barriers to homeownership for POC experiencing homelessness
  - Impacts of stress and trauma on POC experiencing homelessness
  - Innovative BoS programs serving POC experiencing homelessness
- Attendance averaged about 70 per call
- Hope to have visioning/planning session to consider changes to structure for 2023
- New members always welcome!



## **Equity Initiative**





### **CE Equity Initiative**

- Planning for the new assessment
  - Goal: By December 2023, North Carolina Balance of State aims to proportionally increase the scores of Black/African Americans assessed through a revised assessment to 43%
  - Categories of questions: Safety Risk, Housing and Homeless History, Health and Wellness, Family unit, Case management support
    - Focusing on challenges to housing to prioritize
- Bringing It Home Conference Proposal submitted: "Centering Equity to Redesign Coordinated Entry Assessment and Prioritization"
