BoS CoC Anti-Discrimination Policy

- Current policy is more robust than federal requirements
 - o Covers a wide range of identities and experiences
- Document largely provides protections for being denied services
 - We do not usually receive complaints of harassment, microagressions, etc.
- Timeline
 - o Goes to steering committee in May
 - Training for all in May or June
- Edits made each year
 - o Laurel will at minimum update grievance part of policy
 - Does RE subcommittee have any feedback or additional edits?
 - Tambra noted could be used as blueprint for each agency and that checklist for agencies is very helpful
 - Does national origin cover immigration status?
 - That is the intent
 - Does subcommittee want to take on doing bigger edits?
 - Tambra, Dr. Cole, and Kisha already feel like it's so thorough and does not need changes
 - Any thoughts about implementation and if subcommittee wants to support that?
 - More training for providers?
 - Bonnie agreed with more training
 - Tambra agreed with additional policy webinars
