



Racial Equity Subcommittee Meeting NC Balance of State CoC May 17, 2023 at 11:30 AM







#### Camera

We have a lot of people! It may be easier to set the cameras to only show who is currently speaking. You can access this setting at the **top of the screen**.







Are there other ways you would like to act on behalf of this community?




