### **Definitions of Terms**

#### **Imminently Homeless**

- Someone who is imminently homeless is currently housed and being evicted, being asked to leave, or need to leave their housing for another reason (e.g. health/safety concerns, unaffordable rent, institutional discharge, family conflict, etc.),
  AND
- Expects to lose their housing within one week (7 days), AND
- Lacks the resources and support networks needed to obtain or maintain housing.

#### Precariously Housed

- Someone who is precariously housed is currently housed and being evicted, being asked to leave, or need to leave their housing for another reason (e.g. health/safety concerns, unaffordable rent, institutional discharge, family conflict, etc.),
  AND
- May or may not have resources and support networks needed to obtain or maintain housing.

#### Households

- *Households with Dependent Children* include households in which at least one adult and one child are present on the night of the count.
- *Households without Dependent Children* include single adults and adult couples without children. It also includes adults who have children, but whose children are not present with them on the night of the count.
- Households with Only Children (new in 2011) are households in which every person is under the age of 18. This includes unaccompanied children under 18, adolescent parents and their children, adolescent siblings, or other household configurations composed only of children.

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
