▪ Deductible		\$1,156 for days 1-60 for each benefit period (2011: \$1,100). Subsequent costs for ongoing days are different, consult with Medicare provider.	\$140/year (2011: \$162/year)

The resource limits are the same for QMB and SLMB (and in some states, QI): \$6,680 for an individual and \$10,020 a couple. In addition, there is an allowance of \$1,500 for a burial fund. The resource limits for QDWI are \$4,000 for an individual and \$6,000 for a couple.
