#### 3: CoC Application

- HUD issued the FY 2013 FY 2014 CoC
   Program NOFA on November 22
- Projected cut for BoS renewals
  - likely 5% of ARD or \$253,692
- Changes to the FY 2013 FY 2014
  - 2 years back to old schedule?
  - Housing First approach
  - 85% of non-PSH beds targeted to chronically homeless when there is turnover



#### 3: CoC Application Timeline

- **Dec 13:** APRs from <u>all grantees</u> to NCCEH
- Dec 27: Renewal Project Applications to NCCEH
- Jan 6: Project Review Committee orientation
- Jan 7: Steering Committee meeting determine collaborative application CoC goals
- Jan 7: Participant Survey due for <u>all Regional</u>
   <u>Committee participants</u>



#### 3: CoC Application Timeline, Cont.

- Jan 8-10: Individual calls with Project Review Committee members
- Jan 14: Project Review Committee creates ranked list of projects
- Jan 16: Special Steering Committee meeting to approve final ranked list of projects
- Jan 17: NCCEH gives written notice to applicants
- Jan 24: All Project Applications must be complete and submitted in esnaps after NCCEH instruction
- Jan 30: NCCEH hits submit

#### 4: CoC Application Scorecard, Cont.

- Scorecard Goals
  - Agencies have capacity to run effective programs
  - Fund projects that reflect BoS & HUD priorities
    - Permanent Supportive Housing
    - Chronically Homeless
    - Veterans
  - Incentivize agencies to be good partners
  - Bolster Regional Committee performance & capacity
  - Funded projects are good stewards of BoS CoC funding and performing to BoS CoC standards



### 4: CoC Application Scorecard, Cont.

- HEARTH Goals
  - Performance Evaluated across Entire CoC
  - Decrease New Homelessness
  - Decrease Length of Time Homeless
  - Decrease Episodes of Repeat Homelessness
  - Increase Income, Exits to Permanent Housing



### 4: CoC Application Scorecard, Cont.

- Changes
  - Addition of PSH key elements
  - More details within the Scorecard about the APR data reviewed
  - APR data matches CHIN
