  - Grantees: prioritizing turnover units for CH
    - CH Prioritization Policy
    - Maximize current inventory
      - Prioritization
      - Better targeting
      - Creating turnover (graduation) as appropriate

- Increase progress towards ending chronic homelessness
  - PSH Subcommittee: Recommending strategies & policies, setting methods & guidelines
    - Adherence to CH Prioritization Policy
    - Local review of PSH referrals
    - Improved targeting of open PSH units
    - PSH graduation processes



## Strategic Planning Objective 1: Implementation

- Increase progress towards ending chronic homelessness
  - Starting in 2015, Coordinated Assessment will support prioritization and targeting
  - Review of CH Prioritization Policy



#### **CH Prioritization Policy**

- Prioritize CH for PSH
  - Not already dedicated to CH
  - Become available through turnover
  - Hold turnover beds open for 15 days
  - Conduct a search for CH
    - Consult existing waiting lists and coordinated assessment info
    - Poll community partners
    - Other methods
- Help address program requirement barriers
- If CH not found within the 15 days, turnover bed filled by normal process
- Agencies encouraged to use the sample form

### Strategic Planning Objective 2

Increase housing stability

Total PSH participants	1151	1158	1108
Total stayers + exited to PH	1070	1089	1053
% of participants to achieve housing stability	93%	94%	95%



## Strategic Planning Objective 2: Application Goals

- Increase housing stability
  - CoC: Improving data quality and program evaluation
    - Missing exit destinations
    - Performance improvement process
  - PSH Subcommittee: Recommending strategies to increase housing stability
    - Based on best practices and benchmarks



## Strategic Planning Objective 2: Application Goals

- Increase housing stability
  - Grantees: Implementing housing first model
    - Connecting participants to supports needed to ensure housing retention
    - Facilitating connection to PH upon exit
    - Recording all exit information in HMIS
