#### PIT Count

- ALL shelters, transitional housing and permanent housing MUST turn in a **sheltered count form** with bed information
  - These were due Feb 5<sup>th</sup>, but many have NOT been turned in
- Unsheltered Reporting Forms and optional Housed & At-Risk Reporting Forms can be turned in as community totals
  - These must be turned in by February 12<sup>th</sup>.

### **BoS Structure**

  - Expected changes with HEARTH legislation will require more structure and organization as it presents more opportunities for rural continua.

## Elected RC Leads


• Each Region should have elected a Regional Committee Lead at your December or January Meeting.

## **BoS Regional Committees: Geography**


- Discussion:
