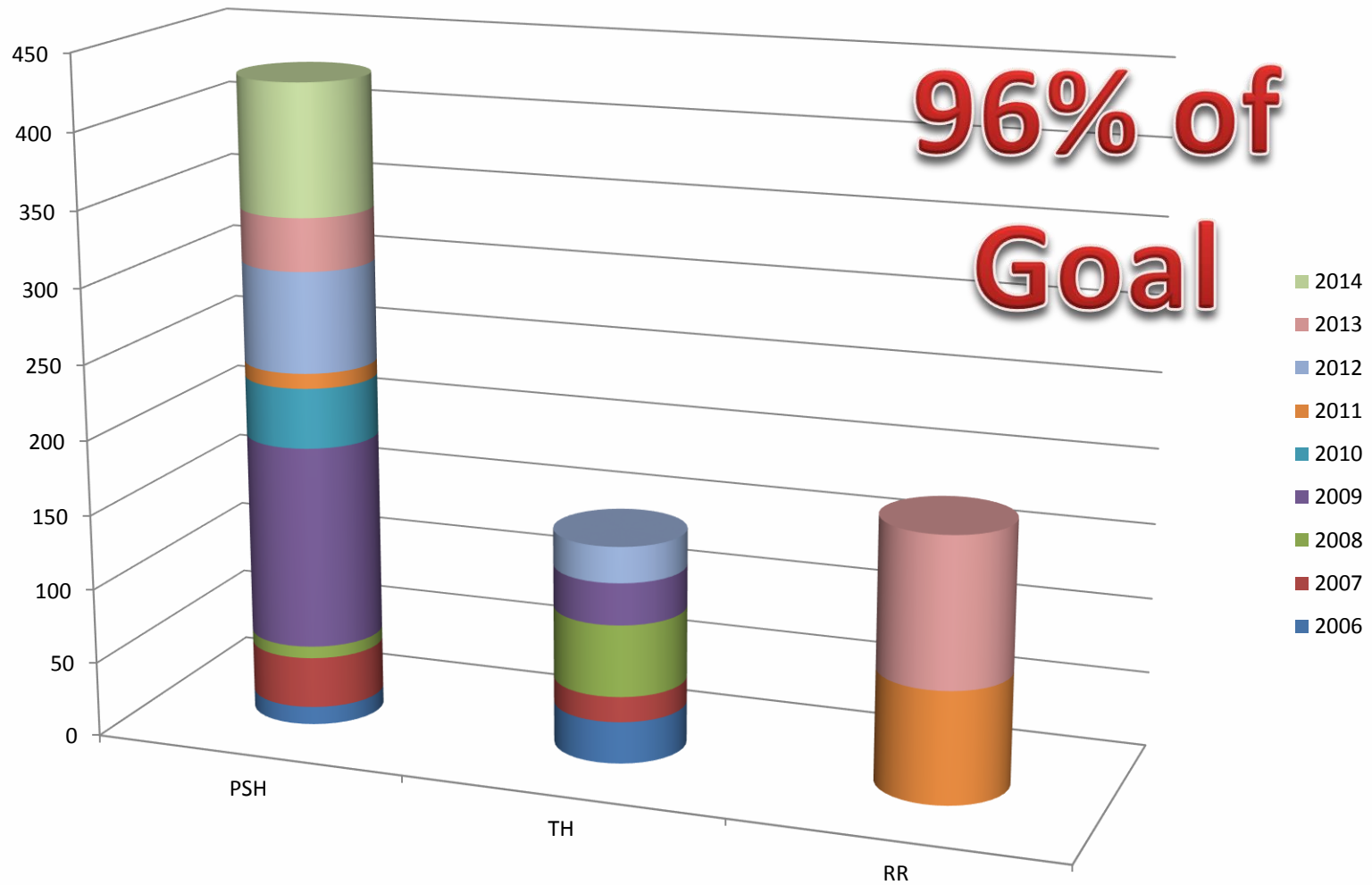

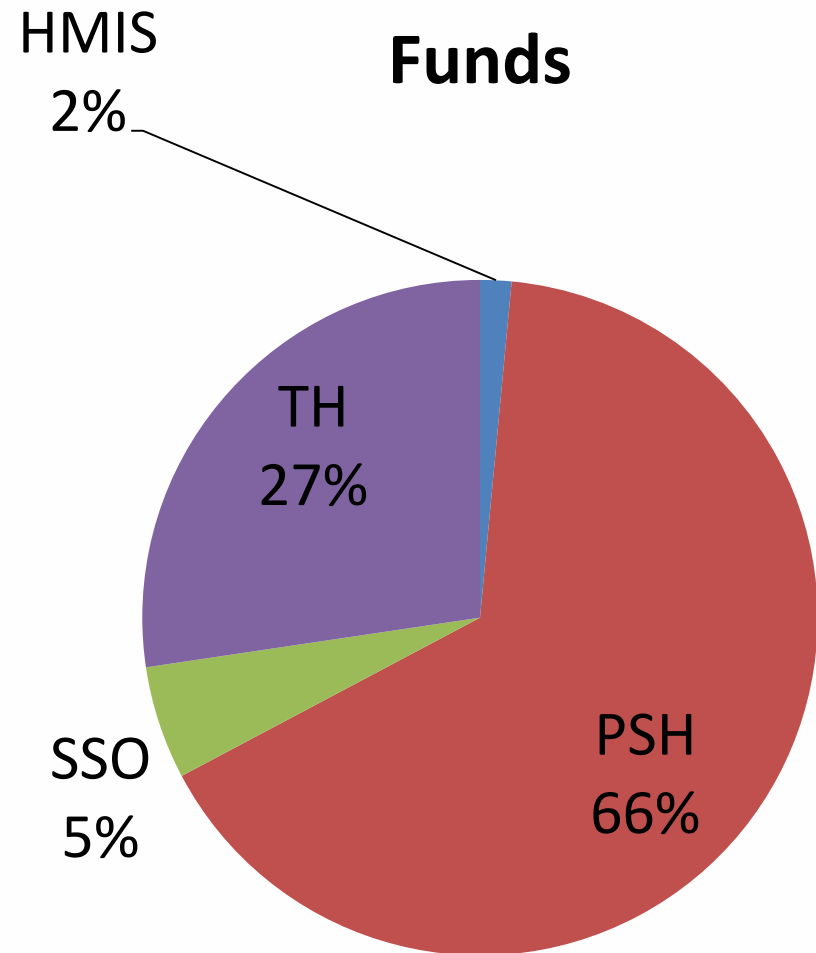

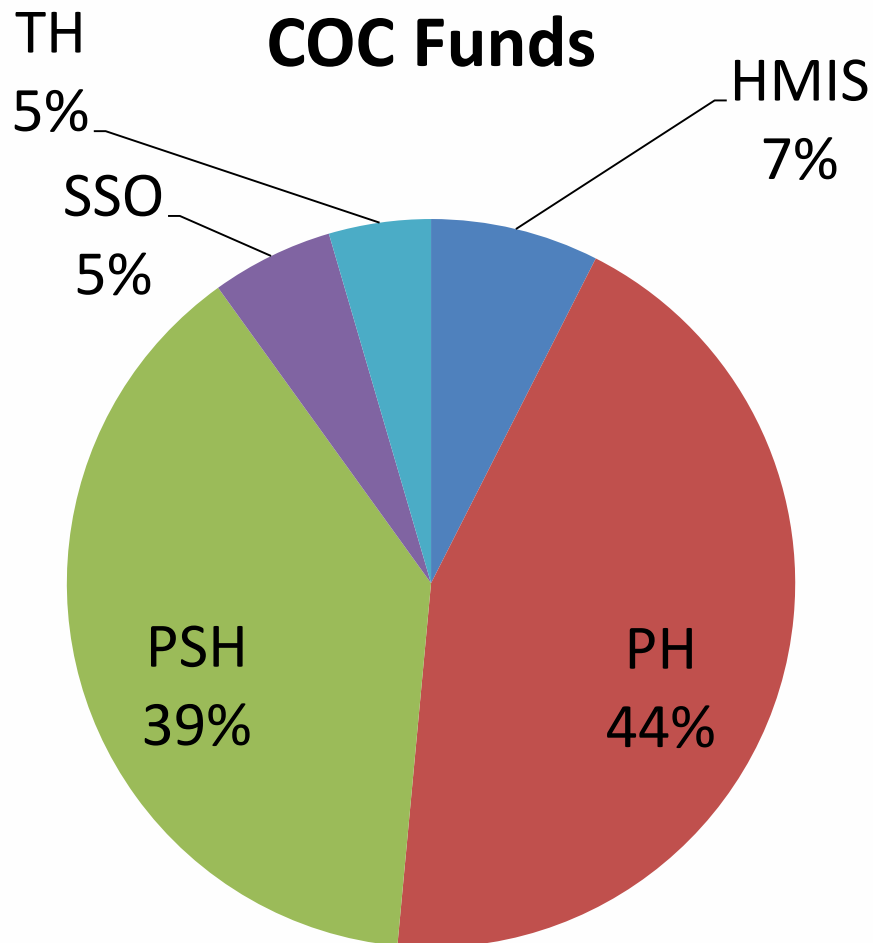
# Develop 598 Units of Supportive Housing



## Total Funds Before Reallocation of COC Funds



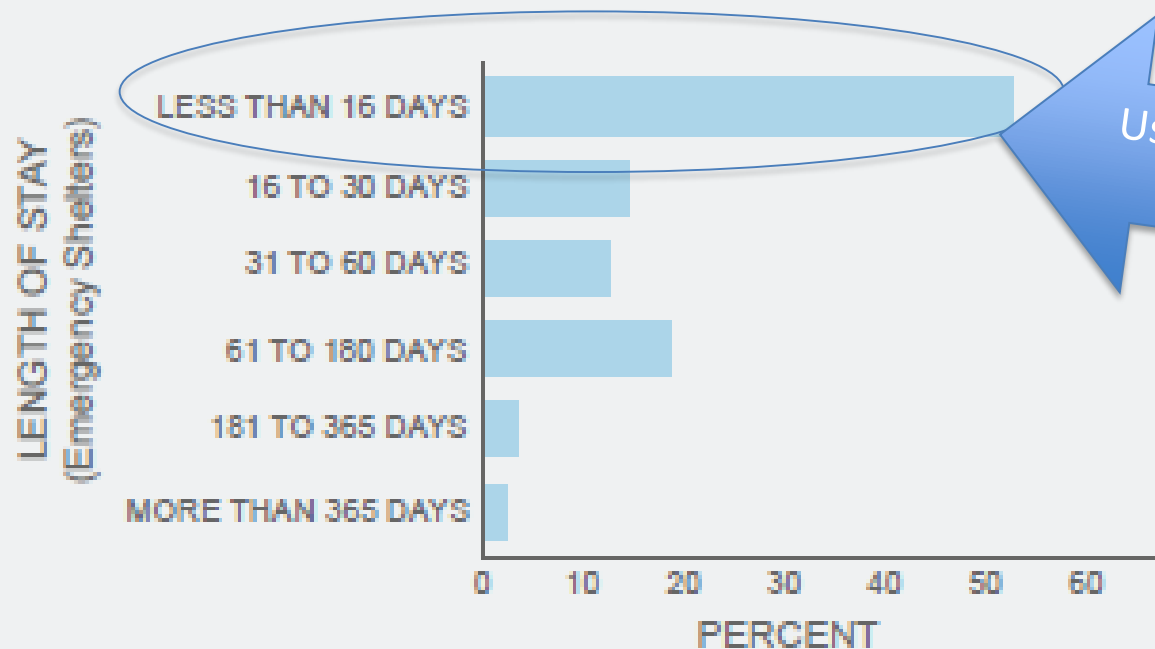
## After Re-Allocation of COC Funds



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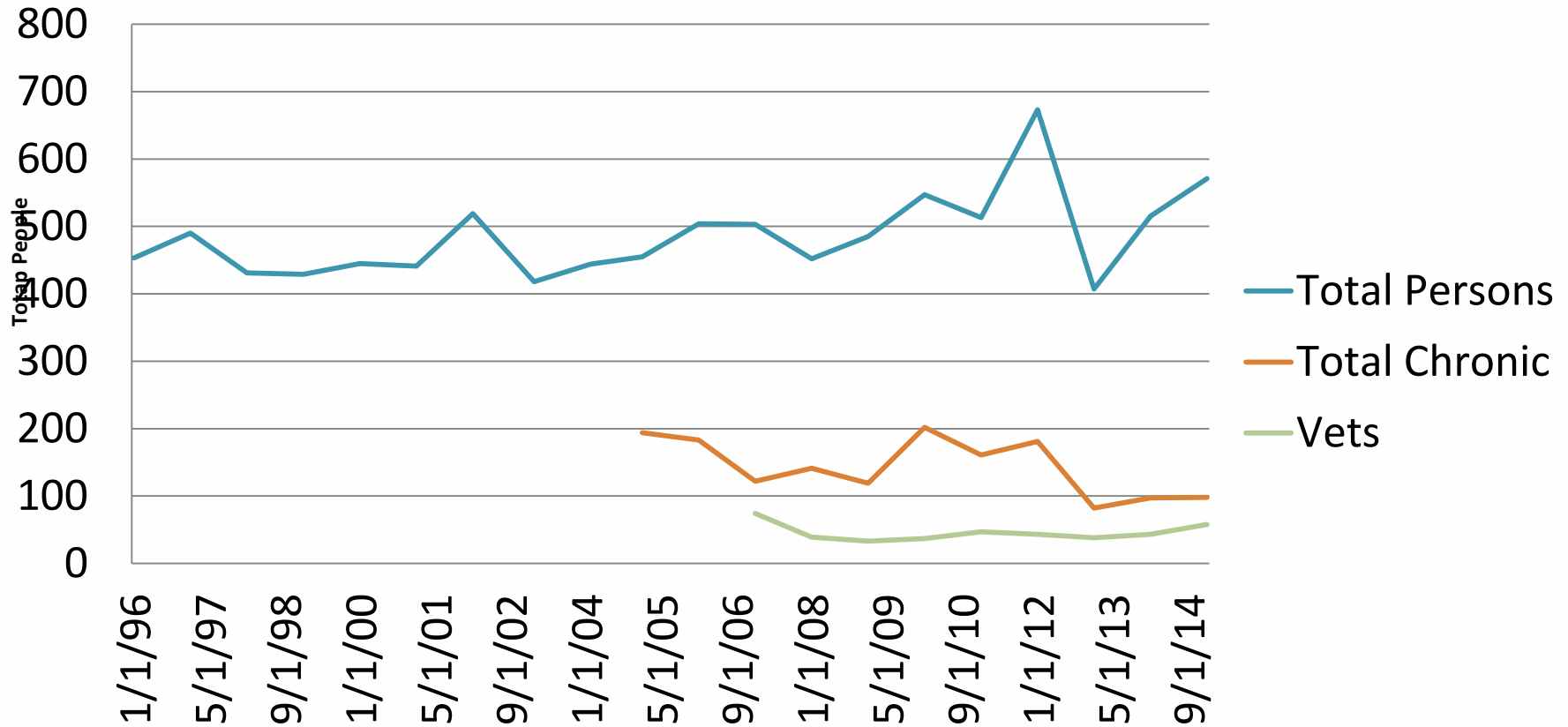

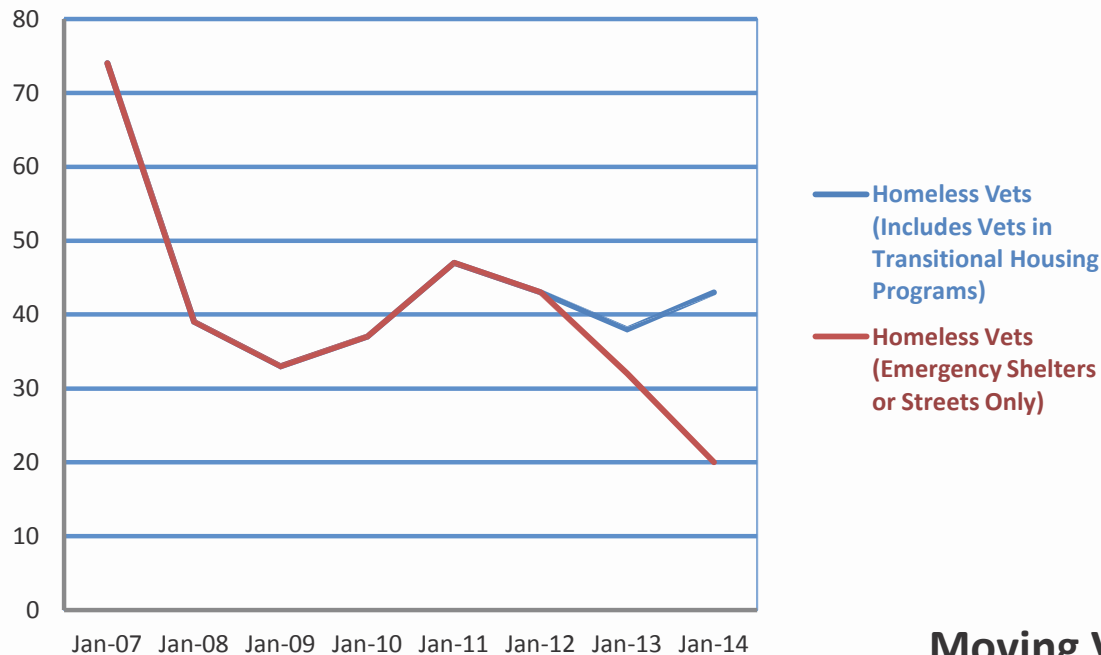
# Winston-Salem/Forsyth County January Point-in-Time Count 1996 to 2015



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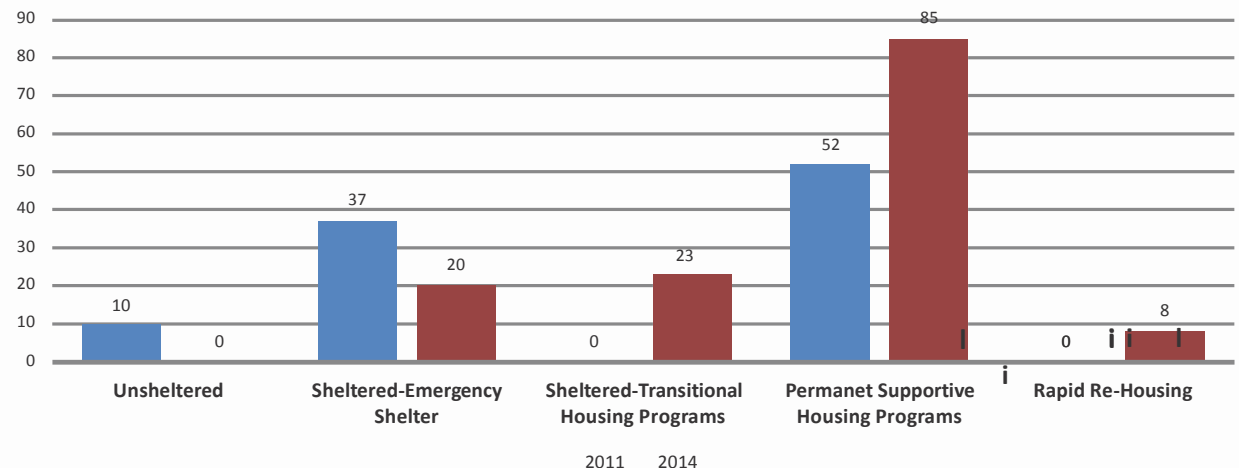

COLLECTIVE IMPACT

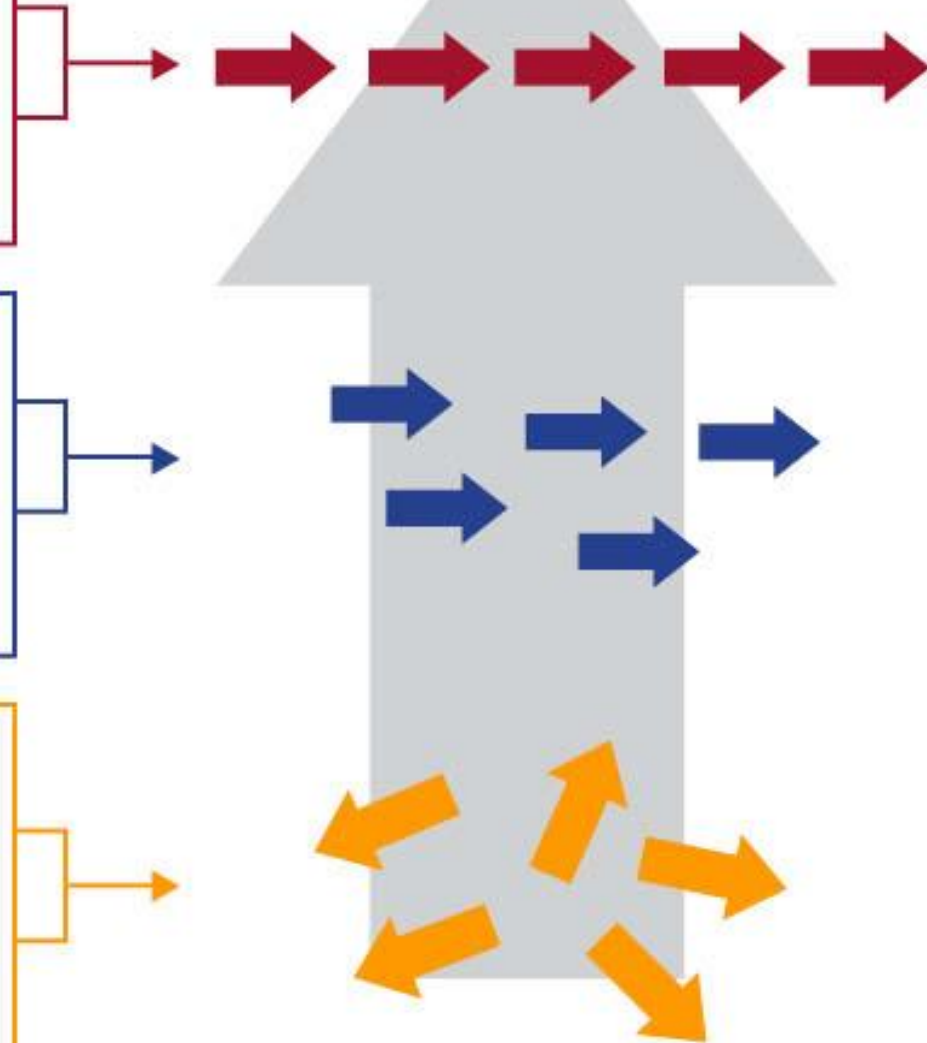
- Everyone working towards a shared outcome

- May share data between organizations

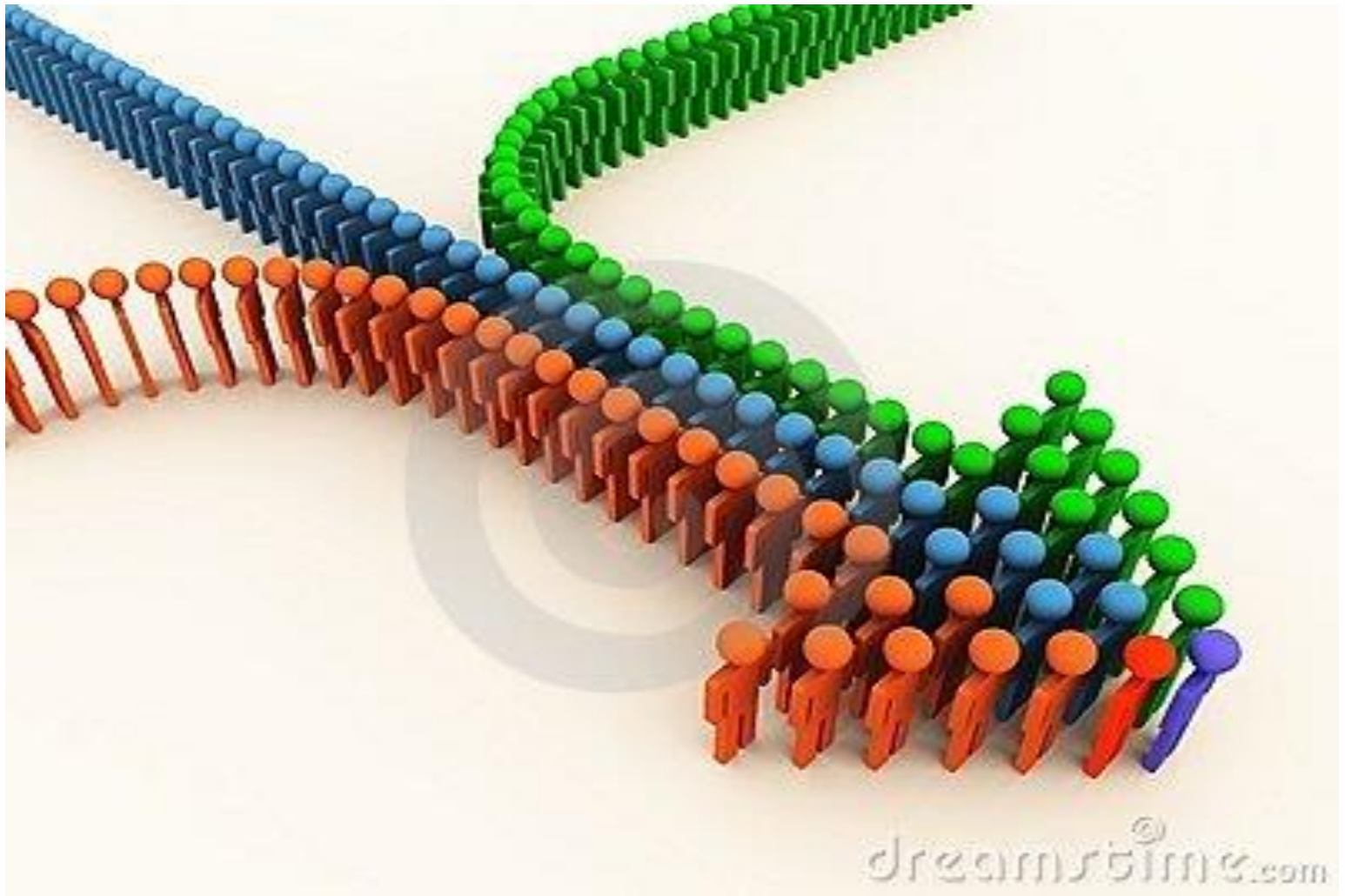
INDIVIDUAL IMPACT
