1. Welcome and Introductions - Arin

2. Community Updates - Community Partner's Updates/Roundtable

- A. Courtney Sapp with Daymark— Spoke about 11 assessments in May for Stanly County and response time 1:17 down from 2:30
- B. Shanta Watkins-Maske—Albemarle Police—moving into old bank—kids played police robbery at bank. Judge presided over case. Fingerprinting. Stanly Community Night out—changed to Sept 22. Overdose on the rise. The numbers are rising... June had 25 OD and 9 already in July 9 days in July—1 death. A female age 74—borrowed pills from friend. Department to start rapid response team.
- C. Jodie Livengood—Guardian ad Litem. Screen, visit children once monthly, to judge objective point of view as to quality and safety of child. They are forming campaign to recruit a few good men, targeting more men to step up as guardian. Stanly every child has voice—share with groups and churches of guardian program and advocacy—makes huge difference in courts. In two weeks 800 people in Winston-Salem guardians will attend conference from all over the state. Dates 7-26-27 at Benton Center.
- D. Priscilla Allison—Community Care. Medicaid eligible children—partnering in Salisbury Rowan Head Start sites. Check for eligibility for dental and medical. Steering to local DSS.

- E. May Walls—VR fiscal year wind down—Working hard on independent living program helping people live independently. VR down two staff members waiting for posting of vacancies.
- F. Arin Wilhelm. He's checking about facebook for Stanly CP group but not look promising. Cardinal issued 4.2 mil in Community initiatives grants. Wants to build a collaborative for Youth MHFA in school systems in Rowan and Stanly.

A. Community Cup

Shifted toward whole person outlook. The parks and rec staff will join CP mtg. Looking at starting a kick ball league age 10-12-up. Get people active—neighborhood, churches, businesses, parks and rec help with organizing and running. Focusing on whole health activities, food, establishing teams of community members. Use the Athletic League website to manage team events, functions. Seek money to cover t-shirt, insurance, etc. and funding from corporate sponsors. Want diverse teams. Have health fairs, vendors, music, food, educational session to open games. Police and fire adopt or create neighborhood teams. Website Arin's club can set up communication to community club. Scout leaders, high school leadership, Pfeiffer has sports wellness program. Volunteers needed to engage with this effort.
