Renewal of At-large Steering Committee Member

Jessa Johnson, Supportive Housing Policy Director at the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, served as an at-large member on the 2019 NC BoS CoC Steering Committee. Ms. Johnson was unable to initially renew her role as an at-large member but has since been able to commit to serving again in 2019. Ms. Johnson's renewal on the NC BoS CoC Steering Committee will be approved at the February 5, 2019 Steering Committee meeting.

Region 11 Leadership Waiver

The <u>Governance Charter</u> states that each agency should be limited to no more than 2 leadership positions per region. Special approval may be granted by NCCEH staff and voted on by the NC BoS CoC Steering Committee to allow an agency to serve in more than 2 leaderships positions per region. NCCEH staff recommends approving Region 11's request for Trillium staff to serve in 3 leadership positions: Regional Lead, Coordinated Assessment Lead, and Webmaster. The Region 11 elected leadership will be approved at the February 5, 2019 Steering Committee meeting.

*Any Steering Committee member may request to move an item off the consent agenda to be more thoroughly considered. Any such items will be discussed as a regular agenda item at the next Steering Committee meeting.

Section II. Updates

HMIS Transition

NC HMIS GC members, NCCEH staff, and HUD TA met to go through documents suggested by NC DHHS and HUD privacy experts to determine the level of breach experienced in the system because of the global visibility setting mentioned in prior reports. The group had several questions after going through the checklist document that have been forwarded to the assigned NC DHHS privacy attorney. Those answers have now been obtained and the MCAH has put together a draft corrective action plan, currently being reviewed by the NC HMIS Governance Committee and NCCEH.

WellSky delivered another demo site for HMIS@NCCEH the week of January 21st. NCCEH Data Center staff are currently performing quality assurance. MCAH and the local system administrators from the remaining 9 CoCs in the NC HMIS have until January 31st to review the demo site for issues. The new system is closer than ever to going live. Right now, the NCCEH Data Center plans to give a two-week notice before going live.

All current end users should continue entering data into NC HMIS until notification is given by the NCCEH Data Center. As soon as NCCEH has more information about the timeline for the transition, staff will send new agency and participation agreements for signature using DocuSign and will indicate when end users should end data entry into NC HMIS and begin entry into the new system.
