- a. VAYA VIP vaya independence project, for high cost members. Individuals that have care management but not on medicare/Medicaid/ssi, etc.
- b. A Caring Alternative SOARS claims are being processed much faster now for disability.
- c. Sharing of Section 8 info Section 8 still taking applications but will close soon. Completely full. Will not consider anyone until 2020, will purge in august those who have not responded. What determines eligibility for application is point system. Points given to veterans, homeless, disabled and DV. Higher points higher on the list.
- d. McDowell Mission opened dialogue with state attorney at ESG conference to work with client finances
