2. Introduction of Committee (those in attendance) and Regional updates

5. PIT Count Update

- a. Emily Locklear explained exactly what the PIT Count was for the new individuals attending the meeting for the first time.
- b. The app was more user friendly this year.
- c. Hopefully the numbers will be ready by the end of March so we can see the snapshot of the homeless population in our region.
- d. 325 Observations of homeless were submitted (but those numbers do not count)

6. CoC Competition

- a. There will be a mandatory webinar for anyone interested in applying for CoC funds on 2/27/20 at 9:00am
- b. SFVC plans to apply
 - i. The Strategic Plan is if selected to receive the funds: the DV Bonus will be used to house DV victims and the ESG RRH will be used to house literally homeless individuals only.

7. RRH Program

- a. So far in 2020 SIX (6) families have been housed.
- b. There are currently EIGHT (8) in the program that are looking for housing. **All of these clients have a VI-SPDAT of 10 and highter
- c. 40-50 people are on the waitlist
- d. Next week, the individuals on the waitlist with a 9, 8, or 7 will be called.

8. B@H Program

- a. Currently working with EIGHT (8) families.
- b. To date 178 people have been helped.
- c. 211 has reopened for referrals.

9. Coordinated Assessment

- a. Hollie Oxendine reminded everyone to record their assessments in the Google Docs. It makes it easier for reports to be turned in on time.
- b. Next report is due on 2/28/2020 and will be submitted based on information in the Google Docs.
- c. The CA needs to be revisited to include the new agencies and remove others that are not participating and change the prioritization schedule for the Waitlist.
 - i. Latasha McNair, Jamonica Watson, Virginia Locklear, Hollie Oxendine, Clementine Thompson-McCormick, and Emily Locklear will meet before the next meeting and present the changes to the group at the next meeting.
 - ii. Hollie will send out an email and a doodle poll to see when is the best time to meet about changing the current prioritization schedule.
 - iii. Hollie asked Latasha what type of prioritization schedule was used for Region 10. Latasha McNair said they use the VI-SPDAT score 1st and then the length of time they've been homeless if the VI-SPDAT score is the same for multiple clients.
