- b. Supportive Services Only-Coordinated Entry Grant (slides attached) NCCEH received a SSO-CE grant as part of the FY2017 CoC Competition awards. The grant will support implementing coordinated entry for 3 to 8 agencies, limited to 1 agency per region. SSO grantees will become CA Leads for their Region. NCCEH will release application materials in a detailed RFP in April for an application due date in May. Applicants must have letter of support from the Region. Multiple agencies can apply, all interested agencies must have support letters from the Region, must be willing to become the CA Lead; only 1 would be selected. Grants range from \$15,000-\$40,000.
