- Hope to bring a draft to subcommittee in July

RE Dialogue Series Workgroup

- April was first of the year on language access and working with Latinx clients
 - Multiple people said that they learned a lot
 - One agency looking for a certified interpreter since that call
 - Agency found interpretation certification classes through DHHS
- How to improve/impact access for Latinx clients?
 - o Language access
 - o Undocumented
 - Cultural (live with families)
 - SSN is a particular barrier
 - How can CoC educate providers on balance of HMIS requirements vs not allowing lack of documentation to deny services?
 - Language immersion through schools
 - o Battered immigrant project through Legal Aid does great education
 - o Need to challenge strict lengths of stay in shelter for undocumented residents
 - o Education and resource list are the two most concrete suggestions
 - Let's marinate and think more next time
- Have 2 more dates set for this year
 - August 29- Environmental Racism
 - October 17- Affordable Housing
