# **Consideration of February's Meeting Minutes**

#### **Updates/Reports**

- BoS Steering Committee
  - The new and renewal scorecards for the FY2024 CoC Program Competition were approved.
  - There will be webinars for both new and renewal CoC projects. For new projects the webinar is scheduled for Wednesday, March 13<sup>th</sup> at 2:00pm and Thursday, March 14<sup>th</sup> at 10:00am for renewal projects
  - o FY 2025 Emergency Solutions Grant funding priorities have been approved
  - The NC Coalition Against Domestic Violence (NCCADV) received a DV Bonus award in the FY21 CoC Program completion to create a CoC wide rapid rehousing program targeting households fleeing or attempting to flee domestic violence, stalking, dating violence, sexual assault, or human trafficking.

# **Community Resources and Agency Updates**

- DSS none at this time
- Coordinated Entry none at this time
- School System(s)
  - Pasquotank (M. Hudyma, unable to attend, but sent updates) ECPPS has identified a total of 164 students as McKinney-Vento who lost housing and are doubled up for financial reasons or in a motel, etc. They do not have a fixed, regular, adequate place to stay nightly.
  - Parents are calling the office looking for a place to go because they have been put out or lost housing, saying they have nowhere to go; referrals are made, but it seems the need in increasing
  - ECPPS is struggling with transporting students that have been displaced out of their school zones. The students have a right to remain in their school-of-origin for the remainder of the school year. ECPPS buses are being utilized but there is a driver shortage and the school system contracts with Kid's Taxi, but they are full as well.

# **Housing Program Updates**

- River City CDC
  - o Inspections have been done on the shelter. A sprinkler system may not be necessary, if they house fewer people in the shelter
  - Received the Choosing Home Grant (SFRF) provides homeless prevention assistance (rent and utility arrears); must be referred by DSS, complete an intake packet, income is calculated at 50% or below; must be facing eviction and have a lease; covering Pasquotank, Perquimans, Gates, Chowan, Camden and Dare counties at this time

- Hampton VA none at this time
- Community Outreach Ministries (Hertford County) will be closing their doors on April 30<sup>th</sup>; they will serve the community in another capacity in the future

# **Success Stories**

- River City shared the following stories:
  - They were working with a female that was enrolled in their rapid re-housing program. She was receiving emergency shelter from a third party in Edenton.
    She has located housing and River City assisted her with securing it. She is set to sign her lease on March 19<sup>th</sup>.

• A young lady was released from rehab. She has secured a job since being released from the program. United Way will be assisting her with a deposit and the landlord is not asking for first month's rent because she wants to be a blessing to the young lady. She is looking to go back into the nursing field.

- River City Group Work Camp will be in the area in July. Applications are currently being accepted. The group will be offering free home repair projects for the elderly, lowincome, veterans, and disabled families. Repairs include: porch repair/construction, step repair, exterior painting, interior painting, weatherization (minor), wheelchair ramp repair/construction, and mobile home skirting.
