### Introductions/Updates:

- Emily Carmody- SOAR Training held in May, SOAR Essentials Training held yesterday in Winston-Salem, and scheduling a SOAR two-day training for the end of August
- TJ Emwanta- Winston-Salem has officially formed a SOAR work group, had 1 approval and 1 presumptive decision this month
- Moli Jones- Still trying to get SOAR authorized by agency for my position, have yet to do a case but really want to be a part of these calls to be kept up to date
- Elizabeth McDermott- Several approvals this month
- Aundrey Freeman- Four approvals in Buncombe County and 3 approvals in Henderson

#### Announcements:

- Outcomes Needed!
  - Please send any and all outcomes to Emily for SOAR cases
  - o Emily is putting together quarterly reports and the annual report for PRA in July
- IPRS Service Definition
  - A service definition for SOAR has been approved by the Department of Mental Health
  - Definition will allow LME/MCOs to be reimbursed for SOAR casework through IPRS funds
- VA and SOAR
  - PRA had a webinar about SOAR and the VA: <u>http://prainc.com/SOAR/library/webinars.asp</u>
  - VA policy about SOAR has changed due to policy in SSA regulations
    - VA staff cannot be a 1696 Representative or advocate on the behalf of an applicant for SSI/SSDI benefits
    - VA staff CAN gather medical records and write a medical summary report for an applicant
  - Community agencies need to be aware of this policy and work to partner with SOARtrained VA staff in your communities to partner on SOAR applications

## **Discussion: Community Work Groups**

- What is a Community Work Group?
  - Group of key stakeholders that meet on a regular basis
    - Shelters
    - Medical facilities- hospitals, clinics
    - VA staff
    - HIV/AIDS organizations

- LME/MCO
- Jail and recovery programs
- o Discuss issues and barriers for the SOAR process in the community
- o Develop plans to address these barriers
- o Train and educate community about SOAR and SSI/SSDI benefits
  - Benefits 101 trainings
  - Trainings for doctors about documenting disabilities
- What advice do ongoing work groups have for those who are starting up?
  - o Have an email list and listserv to share information about meetings and updates
  - o Meet on a regular basis and choose a time that is convenient for most people like lunch
  - Emphasize collaboration
    - Discuss referral systems
    - How partners can provide to aid cases
  - Ask NCCEH for a list of SOAR-trained caseworkers in the community and use that as a starting point
  - o Involve SSA staff in meetings to develop relationships
  - Poll the group as to what is the biggest need in the community and what the group should start on
  - Know that as you begin to address one issue, the group will find other needs that they can address- it happens organically
- Community Certification Feedback
  - Community Certification through NCCEH is a great starting point for work groups
  - Helps groups to follow steps to build collaboration so it is not just one person completing the tasks
  - Creates a goal and motivation for the group so people invest more staff time and energy in SOAR
  - Drawback- communities may assume that they are at a level without actually doing the work and reporting to NCCEH

#### Other Questions for the Group:

- Aundrey- An applicant's benefits were reduced by our SSA office due to the applicant staying at the Rescue Mission Shelter. Have others in the state seen this?
  - TJ- The Rescue Mission in Winston-Salem charges for their services to avoid reductions in people's benefits
  - Moli- I have a person whose check was reduced because of their Shelter Plus Care voucher
  - Emily- SSA office is incorrectly reducing benefits

- Both homeless/shelter situations and Shelter Plus Care vouchers meet "Living Arrangement A"
- The applicant should receive the Full Benefit Rate for SSI
