REVIEWING YOUR SHELTER'S RULES

- 1. **Review** incidents resulting in clients being barred and examine those rules for necessity
- 2. Recognize similar issues that could be handled in other ways
- 3. **Meet** with staff and clients to discuss changing the rules and gather input
- 4. **Review** each rule for whether it helps people get out of shelter into housing or whether it inhibits this from occurring quickly
- 5. **Discard** rules that make it harder or longer for participants to obtain permanent housing
- 6. **Discard** rules that don't make sense anymore or only pertained to one incident that is unlikely to happen again
- 7. **Rules** that remained should be directly related to safety
- 8. Post new rules and let them take effect in 30 days
- 9. Hold frequent meetings with staff and clients to assess how the new rules are working and revise as needed
- 10. Track if the number of people barred decreases
- 11.**Track** if people move into permanent housing at a higher or faster rate
